Verso nuove prospettive?
Towards new perspectives?

Since the early Nineties, to face the railway crisis, the European Union have implemented a program to relaunch the railway market based on promoting competition. The main goal has been to integrate the fragmented European railway network and to simplify the regulatory framework, paying particular attention to environmental sustainability.

The Fourth International Day on "Railway policies, mobility patterns and territory" has the subtitle "Towards new perspectives?".

Its objectives are:

- to bring back the debate launched in the first three editions (in 2011 in Rome and in Buenos Aires in 2012 and 2015);
- to focus on the (further) transformations of Italian and European railway policies in comparison to those of Argentina and Latin America - where neoliberal policies were implemented a few years earlier than in Europe -;
- to assess the direct and indirect effects on mobility patterns and on the territory.

The **key issues** of the International Day will therefore be:

- recent experiences of **transformation of mobility patterns** at national and local levels (in Italy, Europe, Argentina and Mercosur);
- **urban regeneration projects** related to former railway areas (already implemented or under construction);
- evolution of the **political scenarios** and regulatory European and national framework about the railway transport sector, with particular interest in the 25-year liberalization process;
- possible **improvement scenarios** for a real re-launch of rail transport (safer, more green, more inclusive) within the EU aims of promoting free competition of the railway market.

The International Day is part of a joint research project funded by the **Roma Tre University** and the **CONICET Consejo Nacional de Investigaciones Científicas y Técnicas** (Argentina).

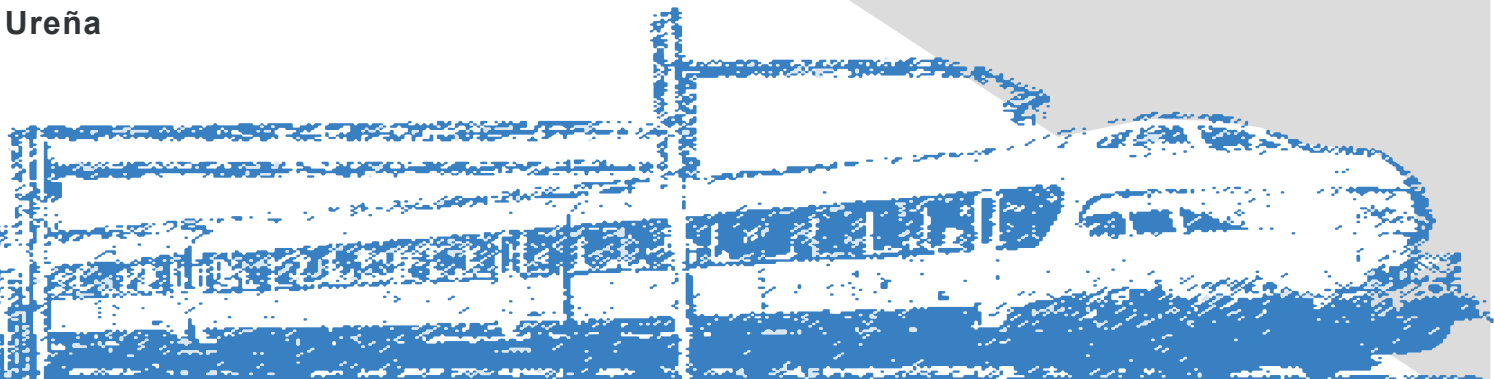
