### Guide for the MSc in (Architecture) Restoration (*English-Taught Program*)

This guide is intended for the **Master's Degree in (Architecture) Restoration** *English curriculum*.

It also applies to the other MSc programs offered by the Department of Architecture at Roma Tre University (taught in Italian): Architectural Design, Urban Design, and (Architecture) Restoration *Italian curriculum*.

## 1 Register for Online Services

Before doing anything else, you need to create an account on the Roma Tre Student Portal. This account will give you access to all online procedures.

## 2 Check Entry Requirements

To be eligible for admission, you must hold:

- A bachelor's degree (or an equivalent foreign qualification) in Architecture or a closely related field
- A qualification that grants access to master's-level programs in the country where it was awarded

### Language Requirements

### International Applicants

If you hold a foreign qualification (**non-EU applicants residing abroad and requiring a visa**), you must complete a few **additional steps**:

- Register on University: [www.universitaly.it](http://www.universitaly.it)
- Follow the official international application procedure

Required documents for international applicants:

- Degree certificate
- Official transcript of records
- Official translations (if the documents are not in Italian or English)
- Declaration of Value or CIMEA certification – [www.cimea.it](http://www.cimea.it)

Non-EU applicants may also need a student visa. Please consult your nearest Italian consulate or embassy for details.

For full details, refer to the Italian version of the official call.

## 3 Request a Free Preliminary Evaluation

Before submitting your formal application, you are strongly encouraged to request a **free preliminary assessment**. This service allows you to:

- Verify your eligibility
- Understand how your previous credits may be recognised
- Receive early feedback on your academic background

## 4 Submit Your Application Online

Applications must be submitted online **between 7 April 2026 and 20 June 2026**. Follow these steps:

- i. Log in to your personal area on the Student Portal (that you created previously see point 1) <https://gomp.uniroma3.it/Login?ReturnUrl=%2f> (**smart\_edu**)
- ii. Navigate to: **Enrollment and Admission Tests** >  
**Master's Degree Programs** >  
**Admission Procedures and Entrance Tests**
- iii. Select the program **Curriculum: Curriculum Restoration / LM-4 R**
- iv. Upload all required documents
- v. Submit your application

Documents required for the application:

- Degree certificate
- Official transcript of records
- Valid identity document (passport or national ID)
- Language proficiency certificate (if applicable)

## 5 Wait for the Evaluation Results

Results will be published on **30 June 2026**. The Academic Committee will evaluate:

- Your academic qualifications and overall GPA
- The relevance of your previous studies to the chosen program

Possible outcomes:

In some cases, the Committee may require an interview or an aptitude test before reaching a decision.

**Complete your enrollment**

If you are a **non-EU citizen** living abroad and applying for a visa, additional steps are required to complete your enrollment. Please follow the instructions below carefully.

**Visa & Declaration of Value or Cimea**

Once you have received the email confirming your Academic Eligibility, you may proceed with the following steps:

- **Student Visa (type D)**  
Apply for a national study visa (Type D) through the Italian Embassy or Consulate in your country of residence.
- **Declaration of Value (DoV) or CIMEA Statement of Comparability:**  
You must provide one of the following documents:
  - a **Declaration of Value (DoV)** issued by the Italian Embassy or Consulate in the country where your qualification was obtained, or
  - a **CIMEA Statement of Comparability**, available via CIMEA (<https://www.cimea.it>)

**Final Enrollment Steps**

You are almost there. Please complete the final steps below to finalize your enrollment:

- Upload your **Visa** and your **Declaration of Value (DoV)** or **CIMEA** Statement of Comparability to both the University portal and your Roma Tre Student portal (smart\_edu).
- Once admitted, you must complete your enrollment by **14 September 2026**.

During the enrollment process, you will be required to:

- submit all required documents through the Student Portal;
- complete any additional academic requirements specified in your admission letter.
